

# BODYCRAFT HOW TO UPDATE LCD CONSOLE

## THINGS YOU'LL NEED:

1. USB DRIVE  
(FAT32 & 2.0 OR ABOVE)
2. COMPUTER



## STEP 1: PLUG USB DRIVE INTO COMPUTER.



## STEP 2: VISIT BODYCRAFT.COM & CLICK ON “CUSTOMER SUPPORT” AT THE BOTTOM OF THE PAGE.



## STEP 3: SCROLL DOWN TO “SOFTWARE UPDATE” AND SELECT YOUR CONSOLE. THE DOWNLOAD SHOULD BEGIN.

There are 3 different Consoles available for each Treadmill, so this Eprom Update is based on the Model of the Console and NOT the Model of the Treadmill Base. Each Console has its own unique Serial Number.

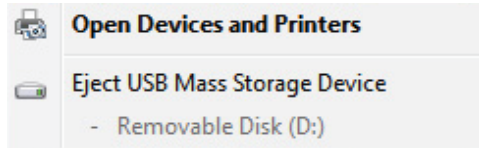


## STEP 4: LOCATE THE FILE IN YOUR DOWNLOADS FOLDER. BE SURE THE FILE NAME IS “AA01770.BIN” FOR 9 INCH LCD DO NOT TRY TO OPEN FILE.

## STEP 5: CLICK AND DRAG THE FILE FROM THE DOWNLOADS FOLDER TO YOUR USB DRIVE TO COPY IT.

## STEP 6:

ONCE THE FILE IS COPIED TO THE USB DRIVE. SAFELY REMOVE THE USB BY RIGHT CLICKING ON IT & EJECTING IT.



## STEP 10:

SELECT "ENTER" TO BEGIN THE SOFTWARE UPDATE



## STEP 7:

PLUG USB INTO THE PORT ON THE CONSOLE.



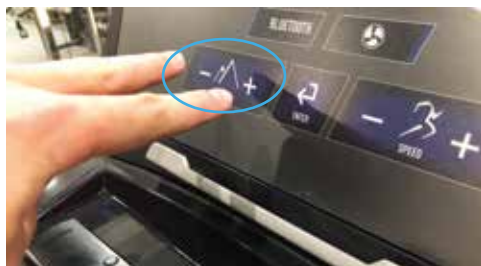
## STEP 11:

THE SOFTWARE UPDATE WILL AUTOMATICALLY RUN. WHEN IT'S FINISHED THE CONSOLE WILL RETURN TO THE IDLE MODE.



## STEP 8:

PRESS AND HOLD THE "+ & -" ON THE CONSOLE UNTIL ENGINEER MODE IS ACTIVATED.



## STEP 12:

REMOVE THE USB DRIVE AND YOU'RE DONE!



## STEP 9:

THE MESSAGE WILL SHOW "SW UPDATE-YES".
